ORDINANCE #134

Be it ordained by the City of Egan that it is deemed necessary for the safety, and convenience of the public to establish truck routes as follows:

- L. No motorized vehicles with a gross weight in excess of six (6) ton shall be allowed on the streets of the City of Egan other than established truck routes.
- 2. Excepted from the ordinance are the following:
 - a. Delivery vehicles with items that are excessive in size or quantity that cannot be handled otherwise which must take a direct route to and from point of delivery.
 - b. Vehicles needed for the operation of the city, county, state or utilities.
- 3. The truck routes within the City of Egan are as follows:
 - a. South Dakota Highway Thirty-four (34);
 - b. County Road K
 - c. Main Street of Egan from the Bgan Public School to South Dakota Highway Thirty-four (34).
 - d. Fifth Street from County Road K to Maple-then south on Maple to Main Street(3rd street).
 - e. County Road Kyon 4th to South Dakota Highway Thirty-four (34).
 - f. South Dakota Highway Thirty-four (34) east on Second Street-then north on Fred to Third Street(Main Street).
 - g. Lift Station on Second Street west to Maple-then north to Third (Main St.).

4. Any person or persons violating this section shall be punished by a fine and or imprisonment as set forth in the Egan City Ordinances.
