Ordinance 190 Noise and Braking Devices

An Ordinance to add a section to the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City of Egan.

190 Engine Braking Prohibited.

- 1. <u>Noise.</u> No person shall make or cause to be made any loud, boisterous, and unreasonable noise or disturbance to the annoyance of any other persons nearby, or near to any public highway, road or common area.
- 2. <u>Braking Devices.</u> It shall be unlawful for any person to operate within the City of Egan's jurisdictional limits, an engaged dynamic braking device (commonly referred to as a Jacobs brake) on any motor vehicle, except to avert imminent danger. A Jacobs brake device, also known as an "engine brake", is any device that converts the internal combustion engine to an air compressor for the purpose of braking without the use of wheel brakes.
- 3. <u>Signs.</u> Signs shall be placed near the primary entrance points to the City notifying motorists of the prohibition of "engine braking". Prior to enforcement, the City shall obtain any necessary approvals from the South Dakota Department of Transportation, and Moody County to place such signs on the aforementioned primary entrance points.
- 4. <u>Violation.</u> Any violation of this section shall be a Class 2 misdemeanor, punishable by a fine up to \$500.00 and/or 30 days in jail as provided by law.
