


ORDINANCE #134

Be it ordained by the City of Egan that it is deemed necessary for the safety, and convenience of the public to establish truck routes as follows:

1. No motorized vehicles with a gross weight in excess of six (6) ton shall be allowed on the streets of the City of Egan other than established truck routes.
2. Excepted from the ordinance are the following:
  - a. Delivery vehicles with items that are excessive in size or quantity that cannot be handled otherwise which must take a direct route to and from point of delivery.
  - b. Vehicles needed for the operation of the city, county, state or utilities.
3. The truck routes within the City of Egan are as follows:
  - a. South Dakota Highway Thirty-four (34);
  - b. County Road K
  - c. Main Street of Egan from the Egan Public School to South Dakota Highway Thirty-four (34).
  - d. Fifth Street from County Road K to Maple-then south on Maple to Main Street(3rd street).
  - e. County Road Kyon 4th to South Dakota Highway Thirty-four (34).
  - f. South Dakota Highway Thirty-four (34) east on Second Street-then north on Fred to Third Street(Main Street).
  - g. Lift Station on Second Street west to Maple-then north to Third (Main St.).
4. Any person or persons violating this section shall be punished by a fine and or imprisonment as set forth in the Egan City Ordinances.

There is hereby declared an emergency and the ordinance shall become effective immediately.
